ART SPACE COMING SOON TO YBOR!

Tempus Projects curates award-winning exhibitions and events and provides a space for culturally diverse artistic expression, dialogue, and reflection contributing to the visual arts community in Tampa Bay. They are opening a new art gallery, Tempus Valta' in Ybor City's historic Kress building on 7th Avenue. Tempus Valta will be one of five art galleries moving into the second floor of this historic building constructed in the 1920s. It now belongs to Ybor City Developer Darryl Shaw, who is also owner of Meatyard Ybor, a property located in the Ybor south area that's being converted into 50 affordable art workspaces and a gallery. THE CENTRO ASTURIANO DE TAMPA CELEBRATING 120 **YEARS**



The Centro Asturiano de Tampa was a social club for immigrants and the descendants of immigrants from Asturias, Spain. Historically, a hospital, cemetery, and health insurance all came with membership, and the purpose of the club was to take care of members at all stages of their lives. This beautiful building now hosts clubs, weddings, parties, celebrations, corporate functions, galas, and more. The Centro Asturiano was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1974 and is a designated heritage structure in the Ybor City Historic District.

INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT UPDATES



The City of Tampa Mobility Department revealed the new enhanced 22nd Street crosswalk and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon for pedestrian safety. The project is made possible through a public-private partnership with Casa Santo Stefano owner Richard Gonzmart.





The 7th Avenue Iconic Archway Light Project with Sidewalk Enhancements is projected to break ground this fall. The East 7th Avenue Gateway Monument & Streetscape Project is estimated to be completed this fall.
