YBOR: HOME SWEET HOME!

More than an entertainment district, Ybor City's residential options continue to grow! This redevelopment trend includes historic renovations, single family infill projects to multifamily residential developments. According to the Hillsborough Planning Commission, 250 new housing units have been added within Ybor City's CRA 1 and 2 boundaries since 2015 with an estimated additional 1,394 units by 2030. The historic charm of Ybor City coupled with its close distance to downtown Tampa and the interstate system makes it a very attractive place to call home.

parking spaces and two-hour free parking in city-owned surface parking lots starting March 14. This program change will make it more convenient for visitors and residents to find available parking. Gas Worx

The first phase of Gas Worx, a 50-acre mixed-use development master plan in Ybor City, received final approval

from Tampa City Council. When completed, Gas Worx will be one of the most walkable neighborhoods in Tampa, with priority given to pedestrians and bike traffic while adding needed greenspace in the city's urban core.



Casa Marti Begins Construction

summer. The monument will represent the entrance to the east end of the 7th Avenue corridor, which was recognized as one of the 10 Greatest Streets in America by the American Planning Association.
